## Complete Spring Protection

Spring is an important time on the golf course. You frantically work to open the course and start conditioning the turf for the stresses of the coming season. The cool and wet weather conditions that commonly occur at this time of year are ideal for several turf pathogens to develop. Foliar diseases like Pink snow mould/Microdochium patch, Leaf spot or Anthracnose may be evident while root infecting pathogens like Take-all patch, Summer patch, Pythium root dysfunction and Pythium root rot develop below the surface. However, these root infecting pathogens may not be visible until the first stress of the season.




